SPORTS NEWS

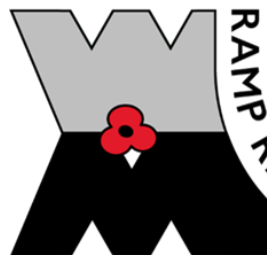
