PARENT CONSULTATION MEETINGS- MARCH 2018

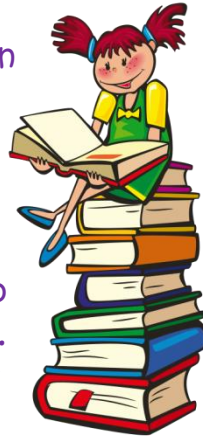

All the commission raised from the fair is used to purchase books for the children to use in school. Children will be able to use their £1 World Book Day vouchers towards a book from the fair.

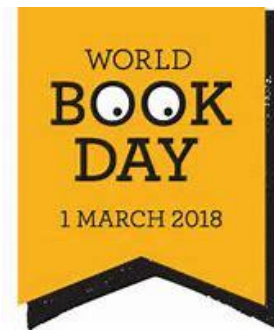


WORLD BOOK DAY & PEARL DAY
