ALLOCATION OF SECONDARY SCHOOL PLACES 2018

The process for admissions to Year 7 in 2018 has begun. The closing date for applications is 31st October 2017. Coventry City Council is encouraging parents to make their application online at www.coventry.gov.uk/schooladmissions. Leaflets explaining the online process were sent home with all Year 6 pupils last week.

Children of parents/Carers who fail to submit an application by the closing date will not be included in the initial allocation of places and the school(s) they have requested may be full.

Applications can also be made online for children starting primary school in September 2018, the deadline for admissions is 15th January 2018.
