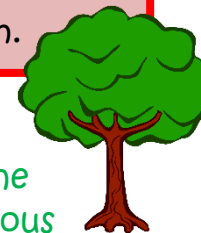

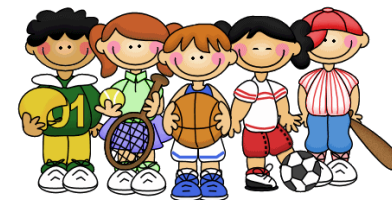
## GLEE PERFORMANCE
