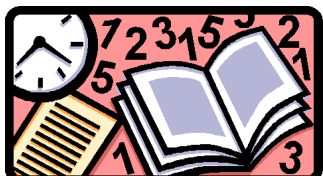


PARENT CONSULTATION MEETINGS
