Friday 14th July – 9.10am for EYFS & KS1

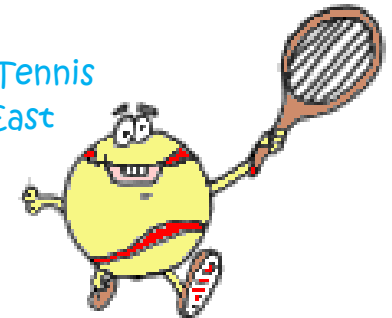
Friday 21st July – 9.10 am for KS2
