COMIC RELIEF

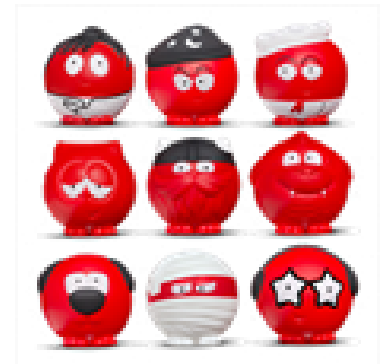
On Friday 24th March the children are invited to come to school dressed in red for a £1 donation to raise money for Comic Relief's Red Nose Day.
