STAYING SAFE ONLINE

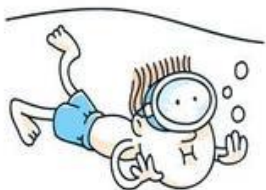
A number of parents have been in touch to ask about how to keep children safe online. Coventry City Council have a link on their website with tips about how to make sure your children are looked after online.
