Deafness isolates children and that affects their health in later life. Sign2Sing brings deaf and hearing children together through sign language, transforming the lives of deaf children.

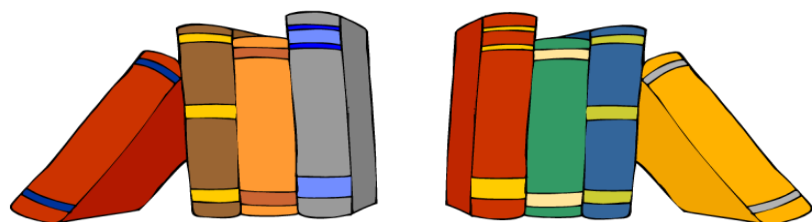
Thank you to everyone who donated £1 today. The children had fun learning and performing their song and we raised a fantastic £200 for SignHealth.

Tuesday 1st March: 3.30pm – 6.00pm (Reception only)

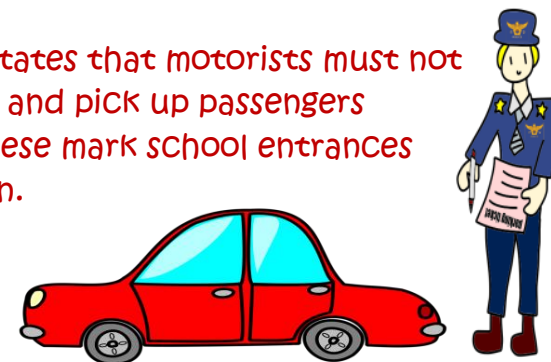
You can book your place on the Parents Evening Booking system. Booking letters have been sent home. Please speak to the school office if you have any problems.

Can we remind parents and families about the need to be considerate when parking outside school.

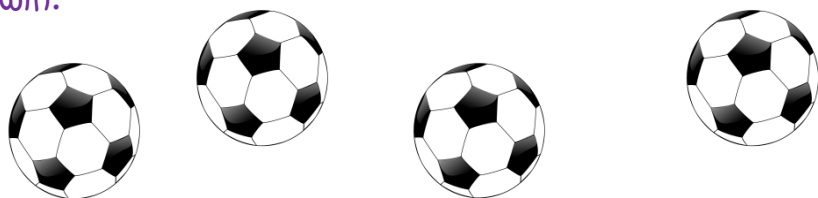
The safety of our children walking to and from school is our highest priority and some cars are being parked in places that put them at risk.
