STARTING SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER 2017

If you have a child born between 1st September 2012 and 31st August 2013 you will need to apply for a reception place through Coventry City Council. Log on to the application process at www.coventry.gov.uk/schooladmissions

The closing date for applications is 15th January 2017.

If you can't apply online, pick up an application form from the school office. You still need to apply even if you have older children already in school.
