CARRIERS FOR CAUSES

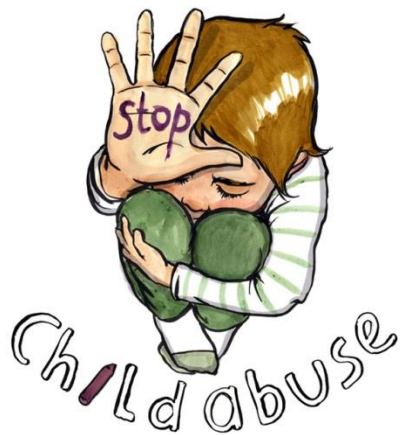
