

After taking the following advice from Swim England, Public Health England (PHE) & PWTAG, School swimming lessons at all CV life facilities will continue to operate.

Public Health England opinion is that it is generally safe to go swimming at this time. Water and the chlorine within swimming pools will help to kill the virus and PHE have also confirmed the following;

“We have checked with our national leads who confirm that coronavirus would be inactivated at the levels of chlorine used in swimming pools.”

We will be ensuring that all children using the swimming pools, are directed to shower before entering the pool to remove impurities typically found on bodies, and to shower on leaving the pool. We are also advising the children to follow good personal hygiene whilst visiting our sites.

Following the above guidelines we are also making the following changes;

- Frequent, regular, testing of the pool water for pH and disinfectant levels.
- Monthly bacteriological tests of pool water are carried out by an UKAS approved laboratory.
- To clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces in the pool environment, ensuring a frequent and regular cleansing regime of all areas used by the public.
