MESSAGE FROM MRS O'HARA

Hello children, parents and carers, it is unbelievable that our school provision changed so dramatically 12 weeks ago! I am continuing to look at the learning you have been accessing online and your teacher's feedback about all the work that has been completed.

Please continue to use our home learning platform with resources being regularly updated by your teachers; check into these as often as you can.

We continue to enjoy catching up with our home learners over the phone, as the school moves to the next phase – reopening to specific year groups the calls may be less frequent, please contact school if you need any support and we will get back to you as soon as we can. Thank you for all the posts telling us about what you are doing on our Facebook page and Twitter account, keep this going.

I was really saddened to be informed that the beautiful snake you have been creating had been vandalised this week. I am so shocked that anyone would have thought to do such a thing. Thankfully a lot of the stones were retrieved by a family from our school and the snake is now re-sited in our Memory Garden at the front of the school. If you would like to continue to add to it that would be wonderful, all I ask is that you let us know by phone and then leave your stone at the pedestrian gate which would lead you into the school office. A member of staff will then collect it and add it to the snake.

I continue to be so amazed and proud of your teachers who have volunteered to come and provide all aspects of learning online and in school. Without them, none of this would have been possible. You all remain in our thoughts, we miss you, lots. Keep yourselves safe and well during these very different and challenging times.



PHASED RE-OPENING OF PEARL HYDE

As instructed by the Government, on Tuesday 9th June we will be welcoming back to school additional Key Worker Vulnerable children. Reception children who have requested to come in, are in two 'Bubbles' and will be in school three days a week on a two week rotation. 'Bubble' 1 starting on Wednesday 10th June, 'Bubble' 2 Wednesday 17th June.

Year 1 and Year 6 children who have asked to return, will be in school three days a week on a two week rotation. Y1 in the week beginning 15th June (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday). Y6 in the week beginning 22nd June (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday).

We have worked extremely hard to prepare the school for the wider re-opening. During this time we have been and will continue to work in partnership with the Local Authority and the MAT to follow government guidance to ensure the safety of children and staff. This guidance includes measures to maintain social distancing, use of PPE equipment and cleaning practices.

Parent and carers, who asked via the Google Survey sent out this week, (9am cut off point yesterday) for their child to be in school will receive a letter today with more detailed instructions about times to arrive and depart and where to drop off their child. It is extremely important that the children returning to school adhere to the guidance stated. It may appear to be very strict and limiting but it is crucial to ensure the safety of all children and staff, which is our main priority.

A risk assessment has been prepared and approved by the Governing Body and the MAT Board of Trustees. This is a working document, it will be available to view on our website shortly. Finally, we will be posting a video on the website and Facebook page walking you through the school and the site for you to see what our school looks like now.


