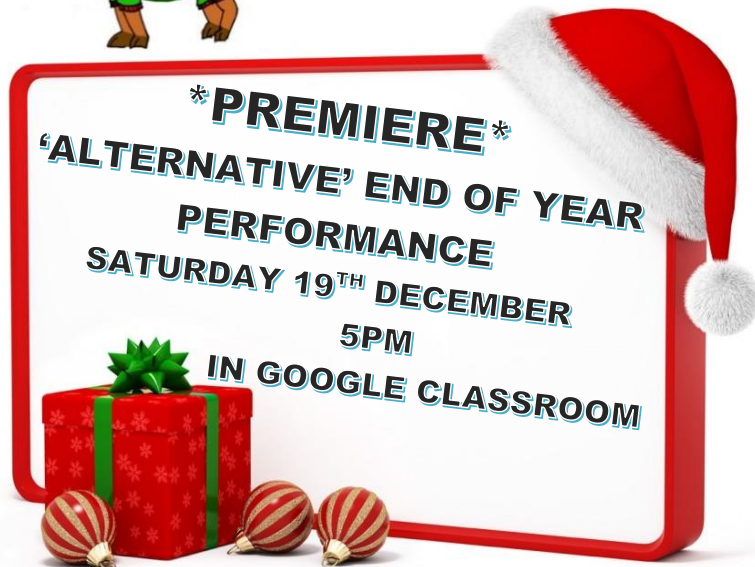
## THANK YOU FROM THE PARENTS ASSOCIATION

## END OF TERM COVID TRACK AND TRACE
