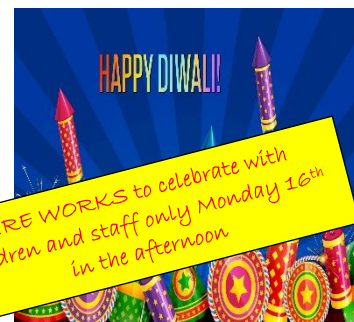
Children are also invited to decorate a stone, which can then be placed in our Garden of Remembrance at the front of the school. Decorated stones can be brought into school from Monday 9th November.

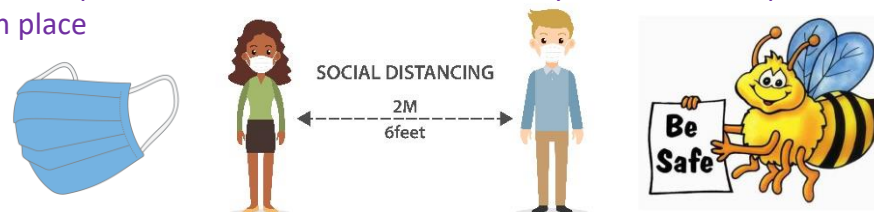

We have a number of children with severe allergies to these products.

REMINDER – children should bring water into school in their bottles.

NEW NATIONAL LOCKDOWN - Important Reminders

- ❖ **Always** wear a face mask when dropping of and picking up your chid(ren)
