



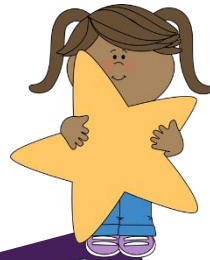

## STAR SCHOOL OF THE WEEK

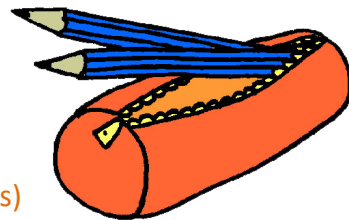
