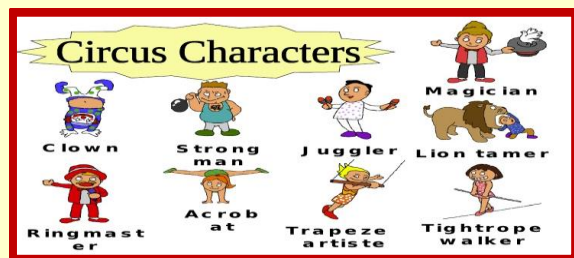


FOR COMIC RELIEF 2021 – FRIDAY 19th MARCH
